

Supplier Code of Conduct – Sustainability

Applies To: All suppliers, subcontractors, and service providers of Crescent NV and its affiliated companies (Option NV, Remoticom BV, SAIT BV and Innolumis BV)

• 1. Purpose

This Code of Conduct defines the sustainability expectations for suppliers within the communication technology value chain. Suppliers must uphold high environmental, social, and ethical standards throughout their operations and products.

• 2. Environmental Standards

Suppliers must:

- Comply with relevant regulations such as RoHS, WEEE, and REACH.
- Minimize the environmental impact of raw materials, manufacturing, and logistics.
- Provide energy-efficient components and support end-of-life product recovery.
- Disclose carbon emissions and pursue reduction goals aligned with [Company Name]'s targets.

3. Responsible Sourcing

- Use conflict-free minerals and transparently report sourcing practices (e.g., cobalt, tantalum, tin, tungsten).
- Avoid suppliers that contribute to environmental degradation or human rights violations.

• 4. Labor & Human Rights

- Uphold the rights of workers across the value chain.
- Provide safe and fair working conditions, especially in electronics manufacturing and assembly.
- Prohibit child labor, forced labor, discrimination, and harassment.

5. Data Security & Ethical Conduct

- Ensure data protection standards for any software or connected devices supplied.
- Refrain from corrupt practices, bribery, or unlawful competitive behavior.
- Immediately report any potential conflict of interest involving [Company Name].

6. Monitoring & Collaboration

- Suppliers agree to audits and must provide requested ESG data.
- Continuous improvement plans are expected where gaps are found.
